### Class

1. Deep Frame.
2. Shallow Frame.
3. Three jars – white.
4. Three jars – golden.
5. Three jars – amber.
6. Three jars – granulated.
7. Comb honey – 3 sections.
8. Cut Comb honey – 3 sections minimum.
9. District Display – 15 lbs. Minimum.
10. Educational Display of Beekeeping techniques (4' x 4' space).
11. Hive products – products made using honey to include: cake, candy, cookies, honey icing or not less than 3 jars of fruit assorted.
12. Bees Wax – 250 g minimum.
13. Jam made with honey – three jars.
14. Pollen – 150 g minimum.
15. Mead – with recipe.
16. Observation Hive – (2 Frames minimum).

### Novice open to first time exhibitors only

17. Novice Class – Bees Wax, 250g.
18. Novice Class – three jars, white.
19. Novice Class – three jars, golden.
