10. No antique dolls.
11. Exhibits **MUST** be picked up at 5:00pm Sunday. If the exhibitor is unable to pick up his or her exhibit, he or she must make arrangements for someone else to do so. The Fair will **NOT** take responsibility for articles left after the Fair.
