The E2 show is a Canadian Goat Society Sanctioned show only for Dairy breeds.

C.G.S. RULES SHALL GOVERN this show. Please contact the convenor if you have questions about show rules.

Regulations for Dairy Goats

1. Refer to Rules & Regulations at the front of this book for deadlines, times and procedures for entry, exhibit delivery and exhibit pick-up.
2. The original registration/recordation paper issued by CLRC for all animals six months of age or older **MUST** be presented to the show committee after the Veterinary inspection. Papers for all animals less than six months must be applied for before the show and a photocopy of applications must be included with the entry. ALL entries must be legibly tattooed and the tattoos must match the original CGS registration /recordation paper.
3. All animals must pass a mandatory Health Check by the Veterinarian to be eligible to move into the pens and take part in the show.
4. VET CHECK TIME: Thurs, 6:00p.m. - 7:30p.m.
5. Animals with natural horns are not eligible to be shown.
6. Over-distended udders will be heavily faulted.
7. No milk to be sold on the fair grounds.
8. The base date for computing age of an animal shall be Sept.6th 2012.
9. To qualify for full prize money a breed must have a minimum of 2 exhibitors and at least 10 animals present.
10. No limits on number of entries per class per exhibitor.
11. Pen space will be assigned in the order in which entries are received. ENTER EARLY!
12. STALL CLEANING at the end of the fair is the responsibility of the exhibitor (we are a volunteer organization!). Cleaning of pens may be arranged upon arrival and pre-payment of \$4 per pen to convenors for payment to cleaners.
13. Show colours for both open Dairy Goat Show will be black bottoms and white tops.

INTER BREED GROUP CLASSES

Class

71. Dairy Herd - Four does in milk, owned by one exhibitor.
72. Dam & Daughter
73. Breeder's Herd - Three does. One milking doe 2 years or older, one dry or milking yearling, one 2012 kid. All must be from one breeder.
74. Get of Sire - Three does, any age, from one sire. One may be borrowed. Name sire on entry.
75. Progeny of Dam - Two does, any age, from one dam. Name dam on entry.

- Golden Fork Award - Best kept pens and presentable animals. Judging during all three days of the Fair. Ribbons 1st – 3rd Trophy.
- Top Herdsman - The herdsman with the most aggregate points for animals and pens. Rosette and trophy.
- Top Breeder – The most aggregate point in 1 breed.
