37. Carcass lamb – no rams

- State the RFID number on the form.
- On arrival at the fairgrounds RFID numbers must match the entry form or the entries cannot be accepted. If a tag has been replaced please notify the convener immediately.
- Lambs are to arrive at the fairgrounds on Thursday September 6th between 3:00 pm & 6:00 pm.
- Pictures of each entry will be taken on arrival at the grounds and placing ribbons will be displayed on the photos at the fair.
- Transport of the lambs from the fairgrounds to Riverside is arranged and all the lambs will be transported together to the processing plant.
- Exhibitors must give their cutting instructions to **Riverside Meats at 250 832-0012** prior to processing.
- Payment to Riverside for the processing is to be made by the exhibitor upon pick up of the lamb on Tuesday September 11.
- Processing of the lambs will take place on Friday September 7th and exhibitors may view the carcasses at Riverside **as a group**, time to be arranged.

FLEECE DIVISION

38. Open Fleece Competition

- Skirt the fleece
- Place the fleece in a large clear plastic bag, with the top left open
- Fleece is not to be tied.
- Fleece must be in place Thursday September 6th, 2012 by 8:00 pm. and remain on display until Sunday September 9th at 5:00 pm.
- Entries will be divided into classes as the fleece judge sees fit to a maximum of three classes.
