Regulations

- Refer to Rules & Regulations in front of this book for deadlines, times and procedures for entry, exhibit delivery and exhibit pick-up.
- **Baking Must be delivered on Thursday September 7th between 9:00am -12:00pm as Judging will start at 2:00 pm**
- All baking must be done by exhibitor as a display item.
- All baking must be homemade.
- All classes are for amateurs only.
- All baking **MUST BE COVERED** with clear plastic wrap, bags, containers or domes. You may use paper, foil or plastic plates or disposable trays – or a piece of clean heavy-duty cardboard cut to fit for purpose of display.
- The size of the tray, plate or pan must be of the appropriate size for your entry – due to display space.
- Baking products with soft tops, meringues or icing should have toothpicks to hold up bag from damaging the baked good or use clear plastic dome covers.
- Part of the judging is based on appearance. The more carefully you package your entry, the easier it is for judges to do their job while still maintaining the appearance of your entry.
- There is no gender-based categories. Male and Female can compete together.
- The Fair and Convenors are not responsible for breakage or damage to items on wrong bases or covered inappropriately.
- **Entry will not be Accepted or Judged if baked from a box or prepackaged mixes, displayed on glass, china or stoneware, not covered with clear plastic wrap, sealed bag or clear plastic dome.**
- **You MUST pick up your entry between 5:00- 6:00 pm Sunday or it will be disposed. If you are unable to retrieve your items at that time, contact the convenor to make alternate arrangements.**

2. Loaf of Brown Bread - Any flavor - not from bread maker
3. Bread maker Loaf – any flavor

4. 4 Baking Powder Biscuits - Cheese
5. 4 Baking Power Biscuits – Plain
6. 4 Biscuits or Scones – any type other than Cheese or Plain
7. 4 Dinner Rolls - any flavor

GLUTEN FREE
