Regulations for Dairy Goats

- Refer to Rules & Regulations at the front of this book for deadlines, times and procedures for entry, exhibit delivery and exhibit pick-up.
- The original registration/recordation paper issued by CLRC for all animals over 6 months of age or older must be presented to the show committee after vet check when asked for. Papers for all animals less than 6 months must be applied for before the show and a photocopy must be available to committee and a copy for the judge. All entries must be legibly tattooed, and the tattoos must match the papers.
- All animals must be in attendance for vet check to take part in the show.
- VET CHECK TIME: Thurs, 6:00pm 7:30pm
- Animals with natural horns are not eligible to be shown.
- Over-distended udders will be heavily faulted.
- No milk to be sold on the fair grounds.
- The base date for computing age of an animal shall be Sep 12, 2023.
- Limit of 3 entries per class per exhibitor.
- Pen space is limited and will be assigned by entry date. Enter early to reserve your space
- Stall cleaning at the end of the fair is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Cleaning of pens can be pre-arranged with a payment of \$5 a pen fee paid to Convenor.
- Show colours for the open dairy show will be black bottoms and white tops.
