7. Comb honey – 3 sections
8. Cut Comb honey – 3 sections minimum
9. District Display – 15 lbs. minimum
10. Educational Display of Beekeeping techniques (4' x 4' space)
11. Hive products – products made using honey to include: cake, candy, cookies, honey icing or not less than 3 jars of fruit assorted
12. Bees Wax – 250 g minimum
13. Jam made with honey – three jars
14. Pollen – 150 g minimum
15. Mead – with recipe
16. Observation Hive – (2 Frames minimum)
