

VOLUNTEER TASK AREAS AND RIGHTS

GATE KEEPERS

Our largest crew at the Fair. Responsible for greeting festival attendees, providing helpful tips, and checking that wristbands are worn by those entering festival gates. Shifts are 4 hours.

ENVIRONMENT/RECYCLING

Maintains the beauty of the festival grounds

HOSPITALITY AND GREEN ROOM

Feeds volunteers and performers. YUM!

COURTESY DRIVERS

Provides transportation assistance using golf carts.

KIDZ KOUNTRY

Plans and implements amazing activities and entertainment for the little people attending the festival

BARTENDING

Serves beer in hospitality (must be at least 19 years old)

VOLUNTEER SERVICES

Meets, greets, checks in and debriefs volunteers. Oversees the snacks and water for volunteers

BOX OFFICE

Handles money, credit/debit transactions and scans tickets at the entrance gates

MEDICAL AID

Administers basic first aid to attendees in need of basic medical assistance (must have a minimum of Standard First Aid/CPR training)

EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM

Works closely with volunteer services, medical aid, and safety crew/event patrol teams to keep communication lines open. Is responsible for implementing emergency response plan in case of an emergency.

PARKING/TRAFFIC CONTROL

Help direct parking and the flow of traffic.

CAMPGROUND AMBASSADORS

Help direct campers to sites and oversee the campsite for duration of the weekend.

SET UP AND STRIKE

Setting up tents, barns, stage, and fences prior to festival as well as post-fest tear down.

SAFETY CREW/EVENT PATROL

Ensure that the festival site is safe and secure. Our approach is proactive, friendly and non-confrontational.

STAGE AND SOUND

Supporting our production crew with set up of technical stuff and building stuff like the pros do.

VOLUNTEER RIGHTS

- Be identified as a volunteer and be treated as an integral part of the SAF community
- Know what is expected of you and to feel comfortable with the tasks assigned to you
- Ask for a change or promotion in volunteer positions
- Be recognized for your contributions to the SAF

VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be happy, smile and HAVE FUN!
- Fulfill all talks, duties and time commitments, as agreed, to the best of your ability
- Represent SAF in a positive way
- Wear your SAF volunteer lanyard while you are on shift (this identifies you to the crowd as an imperative member of the SAF team!)
