- -Open to ages 19 and older
- -Entries are limited to two (2) per class per exhibitor and are to be different varieties.
- -All wine, beer and cider must have been made by the exhibitor.

Kits can be used provided they are produced at home.

- -Clear bottles are preferred. Bottles and caps should be free of old labels and seals.
- -Attach a 3" x 1" label to bottle (with an elastic band) stating what fruit or grape type you have used and variety of wine or beer. Ensure that what you bring in is what you have entered at registration.
- -Screw caps or plastic corks are suggested. Corked bottle entries: please be aware that proper re-corking is not always possible and your entry may be open for the duration of the Fair.
